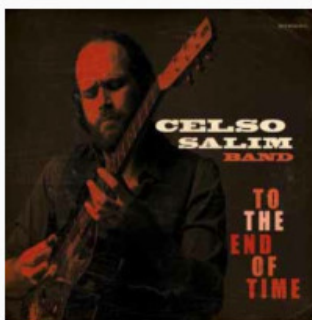


Celso Salim Band - To The End Of Time

That a Brazilian blues band reviewed in Jefferson does not belong commonplace (if it even occurred!). Celso Salim band led by singer and guitarist Celso Salim who has studied music in the United States and who also recently moved to Los Angeles. Both Celso Salim and the rest of the band are great musicians and the interplay between the band members are very tight. Celso Salim Band is no band that draws up the volume and pours on, but

instead the music is airy and relaxed but still with a good turn. Even Celso Salim's vocals are relatively low-key.

Most things on the plate is blues / blues based but Leave It To The Moon by Bia Marchese on vocals is more jazz than blues. Of the eleven songs are eight original songs. The three cover songs is It's Just Too Bad, Liquor Store Blues and Talk To Me Baby. Elmore James Talk To Me Baby is clearly the most intense song on the record, much depends on the guest singer Raphael Curys excellent work.
